I wish to complain about records that are missing from the ministry's response; in particular, copies of minutes of meetings, copies of legal opinions and copies of reports on the RCMP's forced entries, searches and seizures in High River. The Minutes of the meeting referred to in ADM Bill Sweeney's email dated September 18, 2013 (FOIP page 339) and also referred to by other officials on FOIP pages 330 and 340, are missing. Since we now know that the Province of Alberta has paid out at least \$2.3 million in damages in response to the 2,210 damage claims filed with the RCMP by High River residents for damages caused by the RCMP door-kicking spree and the subsequent illegal searches and seizures, it doesn't make any sense that there wasn't one report written for the Minister of Justice detailing how these Charter violations were allow to occur under his watch and how to ensure it would never happen again. http://www.calgarysun.com/2016/06/13/damage-claims-from-rcmps-high-river-gun-grab-total-23-million

The Minister would have obviously been very concerned about the justification for and the legality of the RCMP's forced entries into thousands of High River homes. The Minister and his senior staff must also have been involved in meetings and received reports regarding the Annual Report of the Property Rights Advocate Office for the year 2013 submitted to Justice on June 2, 2014. That official report referred specifically about the RCMP forced entries in High River during and following the 2013 flood and even recommended changes to legislation.

I also wish to complain about all the records that were omitted on pages "37 through 37" citing section 24(1)(a), *Advice from Officials* in regard to the Deputy Minister Action Request dated April 30, 2014 regarding Concerns for an Illegal Search - High River/RCMP Involvement in Indictable Offences (copy attached for easy reference). This exemption might have applied two years ago when I filed my FOIP request while Justice Minister Denis and his government were still in power. But after so many years, a new Minister and a new government, I don't see how these two pages deserve any exemption, let alone a blanket exemption. What could the NDP government possibly gain by keeping this information from High River residents and the public now?
