EXCERPT: Illegal arms are made in almost 50 villages in Bharatpur and Alwar. These villages include Bilakh, Daula Ka Baas, Jurhari, Sesan, Sikari, Gopalgarh, Papda, Jatur, Alla, Andwari, Katholi, Ladmaka, Pathrali, Satwari and Gaunsia in Bharatpur; and Palpur, Kharkhadi, Gvalanda, Nyana, Saidampur, Sirthali and Bhansdawat in Alwar, added the source. Besides this, arms are supplied to dacoit gangs in Dholpur too. In some villages of Haryana like Firojpur, Jhirka, Nagal, Punhana and Gaodi, illegal guns are made.
