- Q: "For the most current CPIC system configuration, please provide a list of all different types of information that comes up on RCMP patrol cars' computer screens when officers type in: a person's name and birthdate, a residential address, a vehicle licence plate number."
- A: When a person's name is queried a response may indicate that there may be records associated with the name entered, or simply that there are no records connected to that name.
 - a. The different types of records and information that can be returned on a queried subject can be:
 - i. A wanted person
 - ii. A missing person
 - iii. A person of interest to police
 - 1. Violent
 - 2. Known sex offender
 - 3. Known prolific/dangerous/high risk offender
 - Known to have observed behaviour that may be dangerous to public safety
 - 5. Known to have a contagious disease
 - iv. A person charged with an offence
 - v. A person awaiting court action/disposition or released on conditions including:
 - 1. A person on probation or parole
 - 2. A person released on street enforceable conditions
 - 3. A person subject to a restraining order or peace bond
 - vi. A person prohibited or refused:
 - 1. Firearms related
 - 2. Driving related
 - 3. Limitation of access to a location/person
 - 4. Liquor related
 - 5. Hunting related
 - 6. Previously deported person
 - vii. Firearm licence and registration information
 - viii. Criminal record information
 - ix. Driver's licence and vehicle registration information
 - x. A person subject to a protective order in the province of BC
 - When entering a date of birth, the system will search for matching data within a 10 year range before and after the date provided.
 - When a licence plate is queried the system responds with the status of the plate and owner information. It may also show that the vehicle or plate is stolen or of special interest.
 - Police officers are able to search using an address when determining whether registered firearms are located at a known address.
 - All responses and information MUST be confirmed with the originating agency prior to any enforcement action taken.
