Researchers looked only at costs associated with the immediate hospitalization after a gun injury and did not consider associated costs after discharge. In that time period, there were more than 336,000 hospital admissions that were a result of a firearm injury, with handguns accounting for more than 70 percent of the costs for admissions for which the type of firearm was known.
