Based on the information provided, a search for records was conducted in Ottawa, Ontario (NHQ Division) with the Canadian Firearms Program (CFP). Unfortunately, we were unable to locate records which respond to your request as CFP do not collect data on firearms prosecutions. However, after consulting with RCMP Legal Counsel it was suggested that the Department of Justice, ATIP branch be contacted if it is believed that DOJ may have responsive documents.

Please be advised that you are entitled to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner concerning the processing of your request within 60 days after the day that you become aware that grounds for a complaint exist.
