We have, however, seen a notable increase in shooting deaths between 2013 – when a low 22 people died as a result of shootings – and 2017, when 39 people died from gunshot wounds. On the (slightly) positive, this figure, however, was down from 41 in 2016. - The Library of Parliament Research Branch determined that the “Presence of a Firearm in Violent Incidents” was 4.1%, but the “Use of a Firearm in Violent Incidents” was only 1.4%.”
- RCMP Commissioner J.P.R. Murray: “Furthermore, the RCMP investigated 88,162 actual violent crimes during 1993, where only 73 of these offences, or 0.08%, involved the use of firearms.”

- Small proportion of police-reported violent crime involves firearms

- Regina, Winnipeg report highest firearm-related violent crime rates among CMAs

CALLS, SAYS TEAM MEMBER - SWAT team used 31 times in 2017, up from 19 times in 2015. On top of just seeing more firearms in Regina, Regina Police Service Sgt. Casey Ward says the weapons they're seeing are more sophisticated. DOUG FORD PLANS TO RESTORE CONTROVERSIAL MEASURES AFTER TORONTO SHOOTINGS

The incoming Ontario government has proposed restoring funding to a controversial violence-suppression unit as Toronto reels from four shooting deaths over the weekend and the homicide count creeps upward at close to a record pace. Early Monday morning, a man in his late 30s or early 40s was shot dead in a downtown community housing complex, pushing this year's homicide count to 48, up 104 per cent over last year. Total shootings have hit 200, a level of gun violence unseen in the city over recent years, according to online Toronto Police statistics.

WASHINGTON STATE GUN CONTROL INITIATIVE CHALLENGED

- "Just because this initiative is supported by wealthy Seattle elitists doesn't mean it could be circulated in a form that violates the law"
- "Reading that petition is like taking a bad eye exam," Gottlieb stated. "When paid signature gatherers told people to 'read it online,' that simply did not meet the requirements of state law," he noted. "Use of such fine print is unconscionable, and when you compound that problem with the omission of underlines for proposed changes to existing law, and strike-out lines showing what current law would be eliminated, it's not just alarming, it amounts to deception."
- The proposed measure not only impairs the rights of young adults to own modern sporting rifles, it classifies traditional semiautomatic rifles, even rimfires, as "assault weapons." It adds a hidden tax, disguised as a paperwork processing fee, on the exercise of a fundamental right protected by the state and federal constitutions, and it requires an ill-defined standard of 'safe storage' that carries a felony-level penalty for a violation.

JOHN LOTT: THE REPORTERS ALSO COMMITTED A CRIME

It is a crime for reporters to pay for leaks. Reporters can use information volunteered by whistleblowers, but bribes are a different story. And it appears to be happening with some regularity. The recent Department of Justice Inspector General's report warns: "We identified instances where FBI employees improperly received benefits from reporters, including tickets to sporting events, golfing outings, drinks and meals, and admittance to nonpublic social events." The report finds that such enticements likely led agents to leak information. So far, the media hasn't acknowledged this possible criminal activity by reporters. The problem goes beyond ethical violations, and it has serious implications.
