- THERE WERE TOTAL 683 DISTINCT PERSONS WHICH TOOK RESOURCE CONSERVATION FIREARMS TRAINING COURSES OFFERED IN PARKS CANADA SINCE 2008.

**(4) the total number of personnel authorized to carry firearms while off duty; = ZERO**

**(5) the total number of personnel that have passed their firearms requalification proficiency and safety testing in accordance with government legislation, directives, policies and procedures;**

- THERE WERE TOTAL 323 RESOURCE CONSERVATION FIREARMS TRAINING COURSES OFFERED IN PARKS CANADA SINCE 2008.
- THERE WERE TOTAL 1,504 PERSON-TIMES WHICH TOOK RESOURCE CONSERVATION FIREARMS TRAINING COURSES OFFERED IN PARKS CANADA SINCE 2008. SUCCESS RATES ARE NOT AVAILABLE AS MANY TESTS ARE NOT AVAILABLE.
- OUT OF 1,504 PERSON-TIMES, 2 FAILURE OR DNQ ON SAFE FIREARMS HANDLING, 48 FAILURE OR DNQ ON 12-SHORT GUN TESTS, 11 FAILURE OR DNQ ON 30-06 SCOPED (P=75/100MIN}, 66 FAILURE OR DNQ ON 30-06 SCOPED (P=90/120 MIN}, 147 FAILURE OR DNQ ON 0.22 OPEN SIGHT (P=150/200MIN}.
- THERE WERE TOTAL 683 DISTINCT PERSONS WHICH TOOK RESOURCE CONSERVATION FIREARMS TRAINING COURSES OFFERED IN PARKS CANADA SINCE 2008.

**(6) the total number of personnel that have failed to pass their firearms requalification proficiency and safety testing;**

- THE DATABASE SHOWS ACCURATE FAILURE RATE FOR EACH TYPE OF TESTS.
- THERE WERE TOTAL 1,504 PERSON-TIMES WHICH TOOK RESOURCE CONSERVATION FIREARMS TRAINING COURSES OFFERED IN PARKS CANADA SINCE 2008. OUT OF 1,504 PERSON-TIMES, 2 FAILURE OR DNQ ON SAFE FIREARMS HANDLING, 48 FAILURE OR DNQ ON 12-SHORT GUN TESTS, 11 FAILURE OR DNQ ON 30-06 SCOPED (P=75/100 MIN), 66 FAILURE OR DNQ ON 30-06 SCOPED (P=90/120 MIN), 147 FAILURE OR DNQ ON 0.22 OPEN SIGHT (P=LS0/200 MIN).

**(7) the total the total number of accidental discharges, unsafe acts, careless storage and unauthorized use of firearms; = ZERO**

**(8) the total number of prohibited firearms, restricted firearms and non-restricted firearms that have been lost or stolen. = ONE**
