WHY BLAME GUNS FOR KILLING PEOPLE?

As Time Magazine reported on a pseudo-scientific study published in a medical magazine: "Firearms are responsible for a more than four-year loss of life expectancy among black Americans – roughly double the firearm-related loss seen among white Americans." Firearms, not other people. But how could a firearm — all by itself — be responsible for killing people? Black or white. The truth is: Black criminals are responsible for killing black Americans. Progressives don't want to say that, and anti-gun activists are eager to exploit the public's ignorance. According to the FBI, 89% of those accused of killing a black individual were black themselves (between 2013 to 2017). The same pattern holds in Canada with Indigenous populations. O&A ON GUNS BETWEEN TRUDEAU AND ARCAND

Trudeau made the comments in French to Paul Arcand on 98.5 FM in Montreal, according to the replay on the station's website today. The Q&A on guns starts at 17:28 in the playback and lasts about 45 seconds. Translated and Transcribed by TheGunBlog.ca Dec 6, 2018

Arcand: My colleague ... told me earlier you are considering maybe prohibiting certain types of firearms in Canada, in other words tightening controls on firearms. It's true?

Trudeau: Yes.

Arcand: You will ban guns?

Trudeau: We are in the midst of thinking about how we will do better to counter violence done by handguns and assault-type weapons, yes. It's unacceptable what's happening.

Arcand: But then, ultimately, banning them?

Trudeau: There are different ways we're looking at, but yes, we want to limit easy access that unfortunately remains for criminals for handguns and assault weapons.

RESISTANCE - Pratte's office organized briefings on the main components of the bill, as well as on the broader topics of gun violence and gun control, in an effort to listen and understand both sides of the sensitive topic. During debate on the bill he described the legislation as "sensible, practical and fair," though he told CTVNews.ca he thinks the bill should be stronger, but is aware that dramatically amending the bill wouldn't be of use if the changes end up being rejected by the government. "We are aware of the political realities, we know that there are things that the government wants to do and others that they don't want to do, so we have to take this into account," Pratte said, speaking to the question of whether unelected senators are more immune to the political pressures faced by elected MPs.

WSJ: SMALL, INEXPENSIVE HANDGUNS MAY NOT BE SAFE FOR EVERYDAY CARRYING

Heading its story, the WSJ spoke to 34-year old teacher Travis Barthel. Barthel, a South Dakota native, regularly carried a pistol made by Utah Inc.'s Cobra Enterprises. As the owner of about 20 other guns, Barthel thought he could trust his Cobra firearm's internal safety mechanisms. But when he left his pistol in a coat pocket, the weapon discharged when he set it down. The bullet hit him in the stomach, severing an artery, piercing his spleen and breaking several rips. The WSJ says it took two surgeries and 11 pints of blood to save Barthel's life. While Cobra maintains its handguns are safe to use when handled properly, Barthel disagrees. By RYAN J. U.K. - THIS IS HOW GUNS END UP IN THE HANDS OF LIVERPOOL'S MOST VICIOUS CRIMINALS

One of the main routes for firearms entering the UK begins in Europe. Guns - particularly handguns - are legally produced on the continental mainland by companies such as the Austrian firm Glock. Converted and decommissioned firearms can also be bought by gangs in Eastern Europe, who then oversee the reactivation of the guns. POLICE WEAPONS: CANADA

The Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) is Canada's national police force. It provides federal, provincial, and municipal police services, and has contracted its services to a number of provinces and municipalities. Reports indicate that Canadian police agencies at all levels both receive donations of surplus military equipment and vehicles and directly purchase military-style items. Generally, police are authorized to use force within the framework of the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms and Canada's Criminal Code. In addition, there are regulations, policies, and frameworks for the use of weapons at the federal and provincial levels. Several recent incidents have reportedly caused some Canadian citizens to question the increasing police use of military-style weapons and tactics.
