**WORDING OF MY REQUEST – FEBRUARY 1, 2019**

For the period from September 1, 2018 to present please provide records related to the Border Security and Organized Crime Reduction Minister Bill Blair's national public conversation about whether Canada should ban handguns and assault weapons reported to include a series of public engagement activities, including roundtables and discussions with stakeholders. Information requested includes copies of records showing:

- (1) The Public Engagement Plan including any amendments to the plan;
- (2) The number of invitations sent out and the number of confirmations received;
- (3) Copies of complaints received about the consultation process;
- (4) The number of complaints from stakeholders who did not receive an invitation and/or confirmation of the meeting times and locations;
- (5) The number of public engagement activities held including the (a) number of persons attending, (b) dates and locations of the meetings and (c) the length of the meetings;
- (6) The number of responses to the on-line-portal questionnaire;
- (7) The number of written submissions received and the names of the stakeholders and organisations making submissions;
- (8) Correspondence, e-mails and texts to and from the Prime Minister's Office to the office of the Border Security Minister regarding the consultations.
