POLICE TO COMBAT FIREARMS-RELATED CRIME WITH NEW STRATEGY

Police also want to buy a "mobile shooting facility" to help investigate crimes involving guns, develop an advanced firearms investigation course, and bring in basic firearms investigation training for all new recruits. Police also plan to

submit a grant proposal for federal funding to address gun and gang crime. Edmonton police have been raising concerns about the increase in gun violence for years. The service's 2017 annual policing plan highlighted an 80-per-cent increase in the use of guns in the commission of crimes between 2012 and 2015. BOTH SIDES OF GUN OWNERSHIP DEBATE CRITICAL OF LIBERALS' ACTION

Blair Hagen, executive vice-president of National Firearms Association, says the current laws target people who are law abiding, and do nothing to stop someone who's determined to get a firearm. "They'll get them legally, they'll get them illegally, if there's no legal mean to it," he told Yahoo Canada. "The demand is still going to be there, and that's still going to be fulfilled. Attacking the rights and property to law-abiding people is not the answer to this."

NEW ZEALAND'S NEW GUN RULES — WHAT CHANGES, AND WHAT STAYS THE SAME

The ban includes any "military-style" semi-automatic guns or shotguns that are capable of being used with a detachable magazine that holds more than five rounds. It also extends to accessories, such as bump stocks, used to convert guns into what the government called "military-style" weapons. Military-style semi-automatics have been defined under New Zealand law as rifles with magazines exceeding seven shots, or with pistol grips, folding or telescopic butts, bayonet attachments or flash suppressors at the end of the barrel. Many different types of firearms, from pistols to rifles and shotguns, can be semi-automatic. Semi-automatic refers to a firearm's ability to self-load, not only firing a bullet with each trigger pull, but also reloading and making the firearm capable of firing again.

REPORT ON HANDGUNS, ASSAULT WEAPONS COMING 'VERY QUICKLY,' GOODALE PREDICTS

Public Safety Minister Ralph Goodale hinted Monday that a report coming soon from Border Security Minister Bill Blair could contain recommendations for action on handguns and semi-automatic assault weapons in Canada. But Goodale, in the wake of a gunman's deadly attack that killed 50 Muslims at prayers in New Zealand, ruled out the possibility of a handgun ban being inserted in a government bill reinstating stiffer controls over rifle and shotgun sales in Canada. In a meeting of the Senate National Security and Defence committee's review of Bill C-41, which proposes to bring back mandatory records of long gun sales and also prohibits certain makes of semi-automatic rifles, Goodale said it is not possible to amend the bill to include a ban on handguns. "I'm told that type of amendment would actually be potentially outside the scope of the legislation," Goodale said. By Tim Naumetz. attacker used five guns, two of them semi-automatic, which were purchased with an ordinary gun license and modified. It was not clear if any of the firearms Tarrant purchased from Gun City were used in Friday's shootings. CONTROL - "What [Australia] did was basically banned semi-automatic guns and handguns," said Irvin Waller, professor of criminology at the University of Ottawa. "I would imagine that New Zealand will look at the Australian experience and it will actually propose what is already legislation in Australia." Waller said it's also possible that New Zealand follows Australia's example by running an amnesty program whereby citizens can sell their unregistered firearms to authorities. Australia held a firearms amnesty in 2017. "I think New Zealand will be going for banning semi-automatic bump stocks. I think they will buy guns back [from citizens] and we will see whether this means that this is the last massacre that they have," he said. EXCERPT: DEFINITIONS: NWEST and the RCMP deliberately abandoned the traditional definition of "crime guns" and instead rely on a new FIESD definition of "crime gun" that adds administrative crimes to the traditional criteria.

FIESD definition of a "crime gun": A firearm is a crime gun if it meets any one of the following criteria: "any firearm that is illegally acquired, suspected to have been used in crime (includes found firearms), has an obliterated serial number, illegally modified (e.g., barrel significantly shortened). (Page 10 of the 2014 FIESD Report). By mixing together illegal acquisition with the use or suspected use of a firearm in a crime blurs the distinction between administrative and violent crimes. This definition breaks with the traditional usage of the term "crime gun."
