



**RCMP ADMITS NOT KNOWING THE COSTS TO PROCESS NEARLY A MILLION
AUTHORIZATIONS TO TRANSPORT FIREARMS**

JUNE 17, 2018: QUESTIONS ASKED IN MY ACCESS TO INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

TO RCMP OTTAWA and Federally Appointed Chief Firearms Officers (CFOs) in Newfoundland and Labrador, Manitoba, Nunavut, Saskatchewan, Alberta, Northwest Territories, British Columbia, and the Yukon.

For each CFO and for each year from 2010 to 2017, please provide copies of records, documents, reports, spreadsheets, evaluations, studies or correspondence showing:

1. the total number of Authorizations to Transport firearms that were issued by the CFO
2. the total number of Authorizations to Transport firearms that were refused
3. the total number of Authorizations to Transport firearms that were revoked
4. the total number of persons charged with a criminal offence while failing to have a valid Authorization to Transport firearms
5. the total number of licensed firearms owners that were charged with a criminal offence while failing to have a valid Authorization to Transport firearms
6. the average cost of processing and issuing an Authorization to Transport firearms

1. **Total ATTs Issued for Canada, by Province & Territory, 2008 to 2017 = 992,139**
2. **Total ATTs Refused for Canada, by Province & Territory, 2008 to 2017 = 17**
3. **Total ATTs Revoked for Canada, by Province & Territory, 2008 to 2017 = 471**
4. **The Canadian Firearms Program does not keep any record of arrests and charges.**
5. **The Canadian Firearms Program does not keep any record of arrests and charges.**
6. The Canadian Firearms Program does not have a specific costing breakdown associated to the process for the issuance of an Authorization to Transport". E-Mail dated Feb 28, 2019

NO 'EVIDENCE' TO SUPPORT BILL C-71 ATT AMENDMENTS

Without having records of the number of arrests or charges for ATT violations and without having any idea what it costs the RCMP CFO's to issue and process Authorizations to Transport firearms, the Minister of Public Safety and the Minister of Border Security and Organized Crime Reduction are unable to provide Parliamentarians with the costs, the benefits or the effectiveness of the entire Authorization to Transport firearms regime!
