GUN CONTROL ADVOCATES CHALLENGE BLAIR REPORT ON HANDGUN, ASSAULT RIFLE BANS

A spokesperson for Blair later responded to the concerns expressed by the gun-control advocates. "The online questionnaire was just one of the engagement tools that the Government of Canada used to contribute to an examination of a ban on handguns and assault-style firearms in Canada. It was designed to be an open, anonymous and barrier-free tool that provided meaningful feedback to the Government of Canada, including from Canadians living and working abroad. It is important to note that the questionnaire was not meant to be a survey or a poll," said Marie-Emmanuelle Cadieux, Blair's senior communications adviser. "Our government is considering a number of actions to help reduce firearms violence up to, and including, a handgun and assault-style firearms ban," Cadieux said in her email response. "We will carefully consider all feedback to determine if any changes are required to firearms legislation and/or the Criminal Code to keep our communities safe. Any legislation proposed by the Government to reduce firearms violence must protect public safety while also considering the lawful use of firearms by Canadians."

On Monday, April 8th, the Standing Senate Committee on National Security and Defence (SECD) reviewed Bill C-71 clause by clause. Senator Marilou McPhedran, who worked with the Coalition for Gun Control while serving on the government's Firearms Advisory Committee, is desperate to ram a handgun ban down our throats before the federal election because she fears she will not get the chance afterward. Senator Don Plett led the charge against the more restrictive aspects of Bill C-71 and successfully added amendments to:

- leave the current 5-year background check in place instead of expanding them to an applicant's entire life;
- repeal the provision requiring a separate Authorization to Transport to border crossings and gunsmiths;

NEW ZEALAND POLICE EXPECT TENS OF THOUSANDS OF FIREARMS IN GUNS BUY-BACK SCHEME

WELLINGTON (Reuters) - New Zealand police expect tens of thousands of firearms to be surrendered in a guns buyback scheme after parliament passed tough new firearm laws in the wake of the country's worst peacetime mass shooting. The new legislation bars the circulation and use of most semi-automatic firearms, parts that convert firearms into semi-automatic firearms, magazines over a certain capacity, and some shotguns. This includes the gun used by the suspect in the Christchurch shooting. It granted an amnesty until Sept. 30 for people to surrender prohibited items. More than 300 weapons had already been handed in, police minister Stuart Nash told parliament.

CANADIANS DIVIDED ON BANNING HANDGUNS, ASSAULT-STYLE FIREARMS: CONSULTATION

The federal report released Thursday says opinions expressed during in-person discussions and through written submissions both opposed and supported outlawing handguns and assault-style firearms. In contrast, most people who responded to a questionnaire were against a ban. Many participants felt strongly that a ban would target law-abiding owners, rather than illicit firearms, and would not reduce gang violence, the report says. NEW REPORT ON POTENTIAL HANDGUN BAN FINDS CANADIANS DIVIDED ON GUN ISSUES

The 31-page document released on Thursday captures the government's attempt to gauge the country's appetite for a "full ban on handguns and assault weapons in Canada," as directed in the Prime Minister's mandate letter to Minister for Border Security and Organized Crime Reduction Bill Blair. The goal of the report is to reflect the tone of public responses, and not to provide policy direction, but it does temper expectations for a prohibition from Page 1. "Overall, participants were strongly polarized on the issue of banning handguns and assault-style firearms," states the first key finding in the report, prepared by the communications firm Hill + Knowlton Strategies.

MINISTERS APPEAR UNFAZED BY SENATE CHANGES TO FEDERAL GUN BILL

Independent Sen. Andre Pratte said the committee's changes considerably weakened the bill. "I hope that the full Senate will defeat these amendments," he tweeted. "Public safety depends on it." Public Safety Minister Ralph Goodale echoed the sentiment Tuesday. "What has just happened is obviously not helpful but the process is not done yet, and I look forward to a more positive outcome at the end." If the full Senate adopts changes to the legislation, those amendments would have to be considered in the House of Commons, setting off "the ping pong back and forth" between the two

chambers, Goodale said. Organized Crime Reduction Minister Bill Blair also seemed unfazed. "We look forward to the Senate completing its work ... so that that bill can go forward."

The Post Millennial contacted the Canadian Coalition for Firearms Rights (CCFR) to discuss the motion and the motivation behind it. "It is unfortunately very common for anti-gun politicians to use senseless tragedies in other jurisdictions to promote their agendas. Personally, I think politicizing any tragedy is disingenuous," said CCFR spokesperson Tracey Wilson. While firearm advocates rejoiced over the decision to not pass the handgun ban in the Senate, some have warned that the Liberal might implement restrictions as part of their election platform. ABSTRACT: In 2016 Adam Lankford published a widely propagated article purporting to show that during a 47-year period the United States represented 31 percent of worldwide public mass shooters, and claiming that the outsized U.S. percentage is a result of gun prevalence. We examined the data from 1998 to 2012 and found that, although the U.S. has 4.5 percent of the world's population, the U.S. represents less than three percent of worldwide mass shooting incidents or mass shooting deaths and less than one percent of mass shooters. What explains this incredible difference? While Lankford claims he is using the conventional definitions of public mass shootings from the FBI and NYPD, it turns out that Lankford's 31-percent claim is an artifact of his having stripped out much from conventional definitions of 'public mass shooter,' notably excluding almost all incidents of terrorism outside the U.S. and most of the cases where more than one shooter is involved. We compare U.S. and non-U.S. public mass shootings using the official definitions from the FBI and NYPD that Lankford claims he is using. NEW STUDY REFUTES CLIMATE-CHANGE ALARM

Scientists who promote the theory of anthropogenic climate change contend a rise in the level of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere due to human activity is causing catastrophic warming. But a new scientific study finds that the current CO2 levels of 410 parts per million were last seen on Earth 3 million years ago, points out Breitbart Editor-at-Large John Nolte.
