POLICE MAKE DOZENS OF ARRESTS IN TORONTO-AREA GANG PROBE

Toronto's Police Chief Mark Saunders says police began making arrests throughout the Greater Toronto Area today, taking 37 people into custody by mid-day with more expected later on. He says the eight-month-long investigation into the organization known as the Chester Lee gang had previously resulted in 43 arrests prior to Thursday's sweep throughout Toronto and the surrounding area. Saunders did not indicate how many charges were laid, but says investigators had seized at least 23 firearms over the course of the investigation.

SENATE VOTES TO EXTENDS GUN RIGHTS IN RURAL BRAZIL

RIO DE JANEIRO — Brazil's Senate has approved two bills expanding gun rights for residents of rural areas. The legislation that passed Wednesday would allow gun owners to carry firearms anywhere on their property and reduce the legal age of possession for rural residents to 21 from 25. People now can carry the weapons only in their homes. TWO PEOPLE FACING 84 CHARGES AFTER GUNS AND GANGS UNIT INVESTIGATION

The investigation was launched June 12 after police were notified that the contents of a package being shipped to a home in Calgary didn't match its description. The package was examined and the item was determined to be a solvent trap, normally used for cleaning a firearm, which can easily be modified into a suppressor. Shaun Alexander Folk, 42, of Calgary, is charged with 51 offences including:

- Unauthorized possession of a prohibited firearm
- Possession of a firearm knowing it was unauthorized
- Possession of a prohibited firearm with ammunition
- Unsafe storage of a firearm
- Possession of a firearm while prohibited from doing so
- Breaching a recognizance
- Possession of stolen property over \$5,000
- Fraud

SURREY RCMP'S MESSAGE TO PARENTS THIS SUMMER

IMITATION FIREARMS: BB guns, pellet guns, and airsoft pistols can pose significant problems for both the police and the community. Since it can be difficult to distinguish the difference between a real and imitation firearm, all calls concerning a possible firearm will draw a considerable police presence. Officers respond assuming the firearm is real until it can be proven otherwise. As a result, parents should be aware that any imitation firearm is not simply a 'toy', despite its intended use. Think carefully before deciding to purchase one for your child and ensure your child clearly understands the proper use and potential dangers. Ensure you both know the legal requirements for the ownership, safe use, transportation and storage of certain types of air guns. Imitation firearms should only be used at designated areas, gun ranges, or on private land. They should also be kept out of sight and locked in a secure case to prevent misunderstandings, accidents, or thefts. For more information, visit the Canadian Firearms Program website. CBC - 'WE'RE IN A WAR AGAINST CRIME': NORTHERN ALBERTA HAMLET PLEADS FOR HELP

Terry Mills's truck sped into the yard at 3:45 a.m. MT on Nov. 8, 2018, confronting the thieves who had smashed their vehicles through the chained gate. They were there to steal gas again. Mills nudged one of the cars with his hood then ducked when he noticed the rifle poking through a window aimed at his head. The robbers sped off, but Mills and a security guard were soon speeding after a black car on the snowy highway. "That's when he started popping shots," Mills recalled. "We're on the phone with the RCMP from Lac La Biche. And I told them, they're heading their way. They should intercept him. And then I said the guy was shooting at us. The officer said 'If you shoot at him, I'm going to charge you with manslaughter.' I said I'm not shooting at him. He's shooting at us."

RESIST - SAO PAULO — Brazilian President Jair Bolsonaro on Tuesday reversed a move to loosen gun control laws by presidential decree, in a strategic retreat after lawmakers pushed back on one of the far-right leader's key campaign promises. In May, Bolsonaro signed decrees easing restrictions on importing and carrying guns and buying ammunition, which needed congressional approval to become permanent law. A REPLY TO GUN-CONTROL ADVOCATES

Currently, 20 states allow teachers to carry guns under a variety of rules on school property, so we don't need to guess what happens when teachers carry. Some states have had these rules for decades. Utah, New Hampshire, Rhode Island and parts of Oregon allowed all permitted teachers and staff to carry guns. In others, school boards or superintendents decided. For example, in Texas, over 300 school districts have armed teachers. After looking at all of the school shootings in the U.S. from 2000 to 2018, the Crime Prevention Research Center, of which I am the president, found two points.

- Commonly mentioned fears don't occur. No student has ever gotten ahold of a teacher's gun, nor has a teacher legally carrying a gun ever accidentally shot someone.
- Outside of suicides or gang violence in the wee hours of the morning when schools aren't in session, not one person has been wounded or killed from a shooting when armed teachers are around.

NRA'S NUMBER TWO RESIGNS, NRA SHUTS DOWN NRA TV

Chris Cox, the former head of the NRA's Institute for Legislative Action (NRA-ILA) has resigned his position. Last week, NRA CEO Wayne LaPierre placed Cox on leave and accused the man many believed to be his evenutal successor of having aided in a failed "coup" attempt against LaPierre by former NRA President Oliver North. In the announcement of Cox's departure to NRA employees, LaPierre thanked Cox "for his service to the NRA." This latest development follows the announcement by LaPierre that the NRA was shutting down production of its online streaming network, NRATV. The Outdoor Wire has also acquired a communication between the NRA and its former agency Ackerman McQueen in which the NRA's Andrew Arulanandam "demands immediate delivery of all materials by Section XLC of the Services Agreement, including all Confidential Information (as defined by the Services Agreement)." The letter also says that "if AMc damages or convert the NRA's property, or if the NRA perceives an imminent risk of the same, the NRA will pursue legal recourse." The acrimonious parting of the ways has been accompanied by a myriad of charge, counter-charges and lawsuits between the NRA and Ackerman McQueen. WASH. POST - WE NEED TO FACE THIS HARROWING STATISTIC ON GUN VIOLENCE

MASS SHOOTINGS make news, and they linger in our collective memory. However, less-public incidents — the ones that happen at home — claim more lives, argues American University professor Rachel Louise Snyder in her new book, "No Visible Bruises."
