
For the period from January 1, 2005 to present, please provide copies of records, reports, spreadsheets, correspondence, presentations, audits, evaluations, investigations, recommendations, minutes, briefing notes, advice to the Minister, talking points showing the total number and types of firearms reported stolen by all police services and public agencies in Canada, including records on the status of the recovery of these firearms and summary of the disciplinary action and charges laid with regard to these lost, missing and stolen firearms.

Further to our response of July 11, 2017 and subsequent to your complaint with the Office of the Information Commissioner of Canada, an additional search was conducted. Enclosed is a copy of all the information relevant to your request, which are disclosed in their entirety.

Please note, we are unable to provide accurate numbers on the recovery details of these firearms. This information would need to come from each individual agency.
