LOOKING FOR SOLUTIONS - Fifteen years ago, the Regina SWAT team could go 18 months without being called out once. But as of June of this year, in response to a growing gang problem in the city, it had been called into action 29 times. At the same time, the city police force has also bought a \$375,000 armoured vehicle and decided to put semi-automatic rifles in every patrol car. Experts, however, tell The Fifth Estate there are other solutions. The approach does not involve adding to the police arsenal, and instead focuses on targeting the few individuals perpetrating the majority of crimes and offering them options: leave the gang, accept help in the form of education, jobs, social support and training or face the full weight of the law. The Firearms Act of Jamaica regulates the ownership and use of firearms and ammunition. It was first passed in 1967, and has been subsequently amended. The law requires gun licenses, with a yearly registration fee of JM\$12,000.00 (US\$ 93.78). YELLOWKNIFE HUNTER UP IN ARMS OVER LIBERAL GUN PLAN

'It's pandering to the misinformed,' says owner on plan to ban military-style rifles.

EXCERPT: Incumbent Liberal MP Michael McLeod told Yellowknifer the definition of what "assault" firearms will be banned is still being worked out. "The intention is to look at assault rifles such as the AR-15," said McLeod, adding "a lot of people are saying we should be looking at the rate of fire as a way of categorizing (what would be banned)." Rate of fire refers to the frequency at which a particular type of gun can fire bullets. McLeod said he doesn't see the proposed ban impacting hunters in the North. "There's not too many hunters that use semi-automatic guns to hunt," he said. "There's hunters that use semi-automatic shotguns — it doesn't apply to that. There's hunters that use semi-automatic .22s — it doesn't apply to that." "So the definition hasn't been defined yet but it's not going to apply to rimfire, it will apply to centerfire guns ...," he added. Centerfire firearms are more powerful than rimfire guns. "We're not sure on the other type of rifles that are going to be considered," said McLeod. The definitions will be hammered out over a two-year consultation process if he's re-elected, he said.

"There should be no stigma attached to peaceful possession of firearms. Peaceful possession of firearms is not a crime, and should not be a crime." EXCERPT: But the RCMP failed to notify people requesting information that it would miss deadlines in almost two-thirds of cases in 2017-18. Its failure rate has jumped from 15 per cent in 2014-15, to 64 per cent in 2017-18. And between 2014 and 2018, the RCMP went from completing three-quarters of its access to information requests on the

original 30-day deadline down to less than one-third. The formal complaints against the national police force top a list of 24 institutions. At 776 complaints, the RCMP total is greater than the combination of all remaining 71 institutions at 705.

MAN ARRESTED AT SFU CAMPUS HAD REPLICA GUN AND RCMP HAT, POLICE SAY

VANCOUVER - There were some tense moments at Simon Fraser University Tuesday as police responded to reports of a man carrying a gun on the Burnaby campus. RCMP officers swarmed the university at around 2 p.m., evacuating two residences in the area where the man was last seen before finally tracking a suspect to a classroom near the WAC Bennett library. Authorities said the 19-year-old man had a bag with a replica firearm, and was "wearing a ball cap with an RCMP logo on it" at the time of his arrest. TORONTO POLICE DENY MY REQUEST TO WAIVE \$300 FOIP FEE FOR 'CRIME GUN' STATS

EXCERPT: "All I am requesting is the updated 'crime gun' statistics for the year 2018. If Mr. McGee has a case make that there is no public health and safety reasons that would justify releasing these statistics and his refusal to waive these fees, then he should provide me and you with his rationale. The federal government doesn't collect these data on crime guns I requested so the public has no where else to turn except to local police services for the information. The federal government no longer charges search and processing fees but that hardly matters if they don't collect the statistics the public needs regarding the sources of crime guns to make better decisions about how best to combat the criminal use of firearms and protect both public and police safety. Given the problems expressed most recently by your Chief of Police, the Mayor and the Prime Minister regarding the criminal use of guns in Toronto, I believe the release of this information would be considered a most beneficial public service."

SCHEER OFFERS TOUGH-ON-CRIME APPROACH TO GO AFTER GANGS WITH MANDATORY

SENTENCING - While any decision to provide a conditional release requires a judge to sign off, the Conservatives' plan would extend "reverse onus bail" hearings for all gang crime offences and those who have been previously convicted of gang-related offences. As it is currently used, that form a bail requires a defendant to prove why they should be allowed to re-enter the community if they were already on a release and violated bail conditions or face new, unrelated criminal

charges. Scheer also said the Conservatives would create a database labelling known gangs as criminal entities similar to the federal list of terrorist organizations. OHIO-TO-CANADA GUN SMUGGLING RINGLEADER SENTENCED TO PRISON

A New York man was sentenced in Ohio in U.S. District Court to 36 months in prison and fined \$30,000 for conspiring to illegally purchase firearms. Benjamin C. Glassman, United States Attorney for the Southern District of Ohio, and Jonathan McPherson, Special Agent in Charge, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF), announced the sentence handed down by Chief U.S. District Judge Algenon L. Marbley. Jerome Watkins Jr., 33, of Niagara Falls, was one of four individuals charged in an Ohio-to-Canada gun smuggling conspiracy in August 2018. Jeremy Hearn, 40, and Marcedes Green, 28, both of Columbus, and Kristina DeLorenzo, 31, of Lewiston, N.Y., were also charged by a federal grand jury in Columbus. According to allegations in court documents, from at least January 2018 until April 2018, they served as either straw purchasers, couriers or resellers of firearms purchased in Columbus and eventually resold in Canada. Hearn would purchase the firearms from various federally-licensed firearms dealers in Central Ohio by providing false information on ATF Form 4473. He traveled to at least 12 different federal firearms licensee stores in Central Ohio. Hearn purchased at least 32 firearms and Green, with money provided by Hearn, assisted in the purchase of at least six of the firearms. Hearn, Watkins and DeLorenzo then acted as couriers or assisted in courier duties, regularly traveling between Columbus and Niagara Falls and/or across the Canadian border for resale. - Create a process in Ohio law, similar to the current probate court process that directs those suffering from severe mental health conditions into court-ordered treatment, to give hospitals and courts a better ability to help those who are legally declared to be a danger to themselves or others due to drug dependency or chronic alcoholism;
- Ensure that citizens have full due process at all probate court hearings;
- Ensure that those legally declared by a judge to be a danger to themselves or others do not have access to firearms;
- Give family members of those who may be a danger to themselves or others because of drug dependency or chronic alcoholism the ability to more easily petition the probate court for court-ordered treatment;
- Mandate that law enforcement agencies and courts enter certain protection orders and arrest warrants for serious crimes into state and federal law enforcement databases to ensure more accurate background check results;
- Create a new private-sale background check process that will increase the number of background checks conducted in Ohio while also protecting the privacy of law-abiding gun owners;
- Create a legal safe harbor for firearms sellers who require private-sale background checks;
- Increase penalties for those who sell or provide a firearm to someone legally prohibited from possessing a gun;
- Give judges a range of sentences for felony cases in which a gun was either possessed, brandished, or used;
- Increase the penalty for those who are found with a gun while legally prohibited from possessing a firearm;
- Increase the penalty for selling a gun to a minor;
- Increase penalties for straw purchases and knowingly possessing a straw-purchased gun.
